Meeting called to order at 6:30 pm by Omar B.

- Welcome
- Land acknowledgement
- Approval of Agenda Motion to approve: Anna R.; Seconded: Melissa R. Carried.

Co-chair Report – Omar B.

- Thanked the co-treasurer for submitting the necessary reporting to the TDSB on fundraising activities for the past year.
- Spoke about the options for the fall fundraising campaign. We have investigated the
 process that would allow us to issue charitable tax-receipts for donations. Wrapped up
 business for past school year. Submitted business report for disbursements for past
 year. Co-chairs reviewed parent engagement and support.

Student Representative's Report – Stephanie K.

- Stephanie reported two requests from NSS student council, for funding:
 - \$1.200 to purchase 34 PALS t-shirts.
 - \$800 to send 20 delegates to a conference in mid-October.

Principal's Report – Adam Marshall

 Parents are encouraged to send in questions before each council meeting, for the Principal to answer in the meeting – "Ask Adam".



- Northern is fully staffed (145 teachers): hired a carpentry teacher, and the business
 department is fully staffed. Support staff are more challenging to find for example, it is
 difficult to get sign language facilitators, and ceramics technologists. We continue to
 pursue possibilities and work with the Board.
- The school is in a space crunch several rooms are being renovated, with one now in use, and the other two ready in late September and mid- November 15.
- Enrolment is up now have 2,200 students.
- Question: how do the school coaches/clubs communicate with students? Answer: Ask the coach about their preferred method of communication. Many use Google Classroom.
- New cellphone guidelines have rolled out positively so far.

Approval of Minutes

Approval of May 23, 2024 minutes - Motion to approve: Anna R. Carried.

<u>Treasurer's Report – Jen Ankemann</u>

- Last year, Council had \$15,500 to spend, while keeping \$2,000 to carry over. We ended the year with \$4,200, which will help fund academic awards for the upcoming Academic Awards Assembly.
- We used the GL41500 Ministry of Education fund to pay for last year's Paul Davis internet safety presentation. The treasurer has submitted council's year-end report to the Board.
- Fundraising: discussion about whether to offer tax receipts for our fundraising campaign, or not. If we don't issue tax receipts, the donations can flow into SchoolCashOnline into a pot we can spend immediately. If we do issue tax receipts, the donations would go into a separate account and would require us to use only board-approved vendors and to issue Purchase Orders. Under this model, it can take up to 30 days to receive the money.
- Decision was made to continue with last year's model (no tax receipts) so we can get contributions in quickly. Approval to seek only non-receiptable donations:
 - Whereas many council expenditures support students and do not use TDSB vendors, parent council should request contributions without tax receipts in our fall fundraising campaign. Motion to approve: Tania O.; Seconded, Kristina T. Carried.

 - o Trustee Rachel Chernos-Lin is taking a leave of absence while she runs in the by-election for Ward 15. In her absence, Shelley Laskin will respond to issues related to Northern.
 - o Director of Education, Colleen Russell-Rawlins, is retiring the position will be filled by temporary staff until the new Director is hired. A search firm has been retained and a survey for parents to share their ideas was made available to all parents until September 22.
